



## **Safari Options and Extensions**

For those of you who either have more time or are doing the Safari only option for your trip or if you want to see more of Africa while you are there, we highly recommend you add some safari time to your itinerary. Your current trip itinerary is a fantastic, well planned safari experience, but Africa is a long way to travel, and to maximize your time and your experience, we recommend the following:

The first is to spend two more nights in the Serengeti at a more intimate tented camp. You will be staying in high end safari lodges with your scheduled itinerary, but they have dozens of rooms and are different than a tented camp with 7 or 8 tents. Below there are three different options for camps from higher end to mid-level. When we say "tented" camps they are not your basic tents, they are more like hotel rooms with ensuite facilities and depending on the camp, range from 5 star to 3 star. In a tented camp, you are closer to the wildlife and in some ways get a truer sense to what it's like to be in the Serengeti.

### **Serengeti extension – 3 days/2 nights**

*Day 1:* Pick up from Serengeti Serena lodge, after breakfast on the last day of your Wilderness Medicine Safari. We do an en route game drive to:

*Day 1 (continued):* After game drive, settle in to your camp. Then, dinner and overnight at one of the tented camps.

*Day 2:* Full day in Serengeti. All meals and night stay at the camp.

*Day 3:* Transfer to Serengeti airstrip for flight back to Arusha.

Another option is to visit **Selous National Park**

---

**Selous National Park**, due to its remote location and because it is most easily accessible only by small aircraft, has remained one of the untouched gems of [Tanzania's national parks](#) and game reserves, and offers visitors a chance to see a wild and expansive Africa far from paved roads and curio shops.

It is home to some of the biggest quantities and largest variety of animals and birds in Africa. Selous has the world's largest number of big game, more than 120,000 [elephants](#), 160,000 [buffaloes](#) and about 2,000 [rhinoceros](#), In addition, Selous contains Africa's greatest concentration of [hippopotamus](#), crocodile and wild dog. The Selous is a rare combination of woodlands, marshes, savannah and open grass plains, crisscrossed by many rivers, one being the mighty Rufiji River.

### **Selous Extension – 3 days/2 nights.**

*Day 1:* Transfer to Arusha or Serengeti airstrip for afternoon flight to Selous. Arrive Selous and transfer to a tented camp for dinner and overnight.
